




«Unofficial» information

- Finance Club (looking for a free lunch & a new job?)
- Business Club (get to know companies and have a beer)
- JobEye or <u>CareerServices</u> (new jobs no lunch though)






Pitfalls & how to avoid them (1/2)







Deadlines are deadlines!

- Module booking: Be on time for booking your courses.
 Deadline is 10 October 2023, at midnight!
- Module booking is registration to the exam and binding!

Fulfilling program requirements

 Start early in setting up a "master plan", begin with mandatory courses

Repetition of Modules

- Failed compulsory modules may be repeated only once.
 Substitution is not permitted.
- Don't take too many courses at first and be aware: some courses have high failing rates (ask tutor/peers)



Pitfalls & how to avoid them (2/2)

Seminars

- A number of ECTS credits must be earned from seminars (details see program regulations):
 - For OEC-students: At least 9 ECTS
 - For INF-students: Between 3 and 12 ECTS
- Good seminars are often popular at UZH. Register early! Information about the seminars can be found on the program website.

Admission to MA with additional requirements

- Complete bachelor courses first and focus on them
- Attention to deadlines

Exchange semester

 Want to spend a <u>semester abroad</u>? Plan ahead and mind requirements (e.g. TOEFL) and registration deadlines

- Identity UZH
- Organize and setup your accounts / passwords (e-mail, <u>VPN</u>, shortname, WLAN, etc.)


Webmail

- Webmail UZH
- E-Mail UZH
- Official e-mail address: name.surname@uzh.ch
- Check regularly or setup a forward mechanism

OLAT

- OLAT UZH (Official Learning Management System)
- Used by most lecturers to provide course material, information, forum, enrolling
- OLAT ≠ module booking!

WLAN

- WLAN UZH
- University campus: Use "UZH" with your credentials

- UZH services
- Provide free software and help with IT problems

Learning Places


Several hundred learning places distributed in all libraries



- Accessible with your ASVZ app






Languages






For international students







Health Insurance information

- Mandatory to take out within 3 months, or to apply for exemption
- Exemption for (most) holders of European Health Insurance Card
- Affordable student plans:
 <u>Swisscare</u> (common choice),
 <u>Academic Care</u>, <u>Student Care</u>

Housing

- Check: <u>UZH housing database</u>
- WOKO offers affordable accommodation for students (apply as early as 6 months prior)
- Comparis flat search aggregates multiple platforms

Mobile Data Plan providers

 <u>phone comparison</u>

Bank & Giro transfers

- Postfinance is particularly cheap
- ZKB & <u>UBS</u> have interesting student offerings




