




Who are we?


«Unofficial» information

- <u>Uniboard</u> (largest University forum with answers in minutes)
- Fachverein Oekonomie (<u>fvoec</u>) (student representatives, events portfolio, informal info)
- Fachverein Informatik (ICU) (official student representatives, file/experience exchange, informal information online)
- Finance Club (looking for a free lunch & a new job?)
- Business Club (get to know companies and have a beer)
- JobEye or <u>CareerServices</u> (new jobs no lunch though)





Pitfalls & how to avoid them (1/2)





Deadlines are deadlines!

Module booking: Be on time for booking your courses.

- UZH: 10 October 2023, at midnight
- ETH: 15 October 2023 (Application deadline of examinations)

Exam registration:

- UZH: module booking is registration to the exam and binding!
- ETH: module booking is registration to the course, one can deregister from an exam before the given deadline. Deadlines are usually reminded by email in MyStudies.

Fulfilling program requirements

- Start early in setting up a "master plan"
- Begin with mandatory courses



Pitfalls & how to avoid them (2/3)

Repetition of Modules


- The Master's thesis is considered a compulsory module. A failed compulsory module may be repeated once. Substitution is not permitted. A failed core elective or elective module may be repeated once or substituted, provided the maximum number of permitted failed attempts has not been exceeded and the module is still being offered. A maximum of six failed attempts at passing core elective or elective modules may be made.
- Don't take too many courses at first and be aware: some courses have high failing rates (ask tutor/peers)





Pitfalls & how to avoid them (3/3)







Seminars

- Max. 2 seminars may be attended
- Good seminars are often popular at UZH. Register early! Information about the seminars can be found on the program website

Courses outside curriculum

- At most 15 ECTS
- Petition has to be submitted
- Similar programs (like ETH Stats Master, UZH Econ, ETH MTEC) offer courses on related subjects which may not be included in our curriculum. Check course catalogue of <u>ETH</u> and <u>UZH</u>.

Exchange semester

- As the program consists of only 90 ECTS an exchange semester is difficult to organize / get approval for inside the regulations (e.g. 15 ECTS from courses outside of curriculum).
 Best possibility to go abroad is with the master thesis.
- An exchange at a partner university of ETH is generally not possible unless you have an ETH Bachelor's degree.

 (e-mail, VPN <u>ETH</u> & <u>UZH</u>, shortname, WLAN, etc.)

Printing at ETH

- 18CHF on your ETH Print Service account (1200 black/white pages)
- Upload your files <u>here</u>
- Check your current balance <u>here</u>



OLAT

- OLAT UZH (Official Learning Management System)
- Used by most lecturers to provide course material, information, forum, enrolling
- OLAT ≠ module booking!
- Beware: UZH course registrations serve as exam enrollment, whereas they are separate at ETH



Technical advice (3/3)

WLAN

- WLAN UZH
- University campus: Use «UZH» with your credentials
- ETH buildings: Use «eth» with your ETH credentials
- <u>«eduroam»</u> available as well, see example below:
 - E.g. With ETH credentials:

Login: <u>username@student-net.ethz.ch</u>

Password: VPN/WIFI password

IT Services

- UZH services
- ETH services
- Provide: free software, online storage space (ETH polybox), help with IT problems



- Accessible with your ASVZ app






Languages

- Mandatory to take out within 3 months, or to apply for exemption
- Exemption for (most) holders of European Health Insurance Card




